General Guidelines

Atrium Health Recognized Holidays

Atrium Health observes the following seven holidays:

New Year's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and December 25th.

- Holidays falling on a Saturday or Sunday will be recognized on a weekday for those departments that close on holidays.
 - If the holiday falls on Saturday, it is observed on the preceding Friday.
 - If the holiday falls on Sunday, it is observed on the following Monday.

Holiday Pay

- All non-leadership, non-exempt (hourly) team members working on select Atrium Health holidays will be awarded holiday pay. Select exempt (salaried) team members, based on the market, will be awarded holiday pay. The select holidays for which a team member will receive holiday pay include Thanksgiving, December 25th, and New Year's Day.
- The holiday period is defined as 6:45 p.m. the day prior to the holiday to 7:15 p.m. the day of the holiday. Team members working anytime during these hours will be awarded holiday pay for hours worked.
